1. **Temporary replacement information of long duration for TXKF Sections GEN 2.1; GEN 4.1, and GEN 4.2 of the AIP Bermuda**

Aerodrome Fees are updated each year, on 15th March, in accordance with the provisions of the Airport Authority Project Agreement, and issued by the Airport Authority in accordance with the Bermuda Airport Authority Act. And Bermuda Public Holiday calendar is to be updated annually.

**3.1 LEGISLATED RATES/SECURITY**

The actual cost for Security Charge for manpower at Hold Baggage Screening and Passenger Screening is divided amongst airlines.

**3.2 LANDING FEES**

<b>Landing Fees - per 1000 pounds gross weight of aircraft</b>	
an aircraft of a signatory airline (commercial, cargo only & combined).	\$4.62 per 1000 pounds gross weight of aircraft
an aircraft of a non-signatory airline	\$8.57 per 1000 pounds gross weight of aircraft
a general aviation aircraft	\$8.57 per 1000 pounds gross weight of aircraft

During uncontrolled hours of operations:

- a. BFRS/ARFF will be called out at CAT 9 (unless other provisions are prearranged and approved).
- b. ATC service requests during uncontrolled hours is per pilot request at a rate of \$150.00 per hour with a minimum of 3 hours.
- c. Fixed Base Operators (FBO)/Ground Support shall be arranged directly with them.
- d. For additional aerodrome related charges, contact the Bermuda Airport Authority for information.
